- ✓ Hydraulic rear door with 3 grain chutes (600 x 270 mm)
- ✓ Mobile sloping front wall with steel posts and perspex closing plate
- ✓ Conveyor belt driven by 2 hydraulic motors with unloading assistance to prevent any stretching of the belt
- ✓ Hydro-Tandem with ADR 150 axles and 420 x 180 mm brakes
- ✓ Rear free steering axle
- ✓ Air brakes in proportion to the load
- ✓ Wheels 710/50R26.5 (Mitas Agritererra 02 170 D (Ø 1,388 x 737 mm, 8,160 kg at 40 km/h and 4 bar)
- ✓ Sprung drawbar (parabolic cross leaves) for maximum driving comfort and stability
- ✓ Unloading controls in the cab and at the back of the vehicle
- ✓ Complete electrohydraulic control of the machine on switch box
- ✓ Hydraulic non-hermetic galvanized steel extensions to increase the body volume up to 42.5 m³ (or 45.5 m³ with dome) for products with low density
